11 **WHEREAS**, Aaron Fleeman, the duly-elected, qualified, and acting Justice of the
12 Peace for District Number 1 of the Mississippi County Quorum Court resigned on April 8,
13 2022; and

15 **WHEREAS**, this resolution was published on April 27, 2021, which was prior to
16 the meeting date of the Quorum Court at which such Resolution is considered by the Court;

19 **WHEREAS**, the Mississippi County Quorum Court, under the provisions of
20 Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-14-1309, *et seq.* doth now determine that a condition
21 of vacancy exists in the Office of Justice of the Peace of District No. 1 of Mississippi
22 County, Arkansas due to the resignation of Aaron Fleeman.

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND DECLARED**
25 **THAT** a condition of vacancy exists in the Office of Justice of the Peace for District No. 1

4 **A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE EMPLOYMENT**
5 **POLICY HANDBOOK OF MISSISSIPPI COUNTY, ARKANSAS**

7 **WHEREAS**, the Quorum Court of Mississippi County has found and determined that
8 tracking the Mississippi County Sheriff's Department's overtime would be more easily performed
9 over a shorter work period than the current 28 days; and
10

11 **WHEREAS**, as a measure to alleviate this burden, the Employment Policy Handbook shall
12 be amended so that the normal work week for law enforcement, jailers, and ambulance personnel
13 shall be no more than eighty-six hours within a fourteen consecutive day work period; and
14

15 **WHEREAS**, The Personnel Committee has reviewed and recommended this measure to
16 the Quorum Court.

20 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MISSISSIPPI**
21 **COUNTY, ARKANSAS THAT THE MISSISSIPPI COUNTY EMPLOYMENT POLICY**
22 **HANDBOOK SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

24 **“Section Four (4) – General Working Hours, Compensation and**
25 **Leave**

26
27 **Section VI. – Compensatory Leave**
28

29 **Paragraph F. The normal work period shall be 40 hours per**
30 **week for all employees except employees engaged in the**
31 **provisions of law enforcement (including jailers) and**
32 **ambulance services. The normal work week for law**
33 **enforcement (including jailers) and ambulance personnel shall**
34 **be no more than 171 hours in a 28 consecutive day work period.**
35 **86 hours in a 14 consecutive day work period.**

37 All other articles of the policy book shall remain in the same form as originally approved.
