Moving to a smaller, rural town, it could have been easy for Jeffers to complain about having nothing to do. She looked around and started to make things happen.

Thanks to Jeffers and other volunteers, a family dance is held every Thursday night at the Caraway Community Center. The dance is held from 7-9:30 p.m. Before the dance, a meal is served from 5:30 -7.

There is no charge for the meal, it is provided through donations.

We take the donations and put it back into the meals and other activities," she said. "I could not do all of this myself. Several volunteers help."

The local band, Gary and the Country Travelers, rent the community center and they do charge a small fee which goes for their expenses.

In addition to the Thursday night events, free sack lunches are distributed throughout the community every Friday. They distribute 50 to 70 sack lunches each week.
