- 2. Quorum Court December 20th at 6:00 p.m. Osceola Courthouse. County Clerk Janice Currie had the millage rates, Ordinance from Wayne Reynolds regarding 911 addresses. two Resolutions for two J.P.'s. Swearing in would be on January 1, 2023. Time would be decided. Organizational changes could be done at that time.
- 3. Jeremy Thomas and Coroner's budget request would be addressed in January.
- 4. The county was eligible for \$50,000.00 this year and \$50,000.00 next year for shared Federal money. Military bases were eligible. Defense appropriation bill passed. Justice Ash asked about the tax settlement. Available Wednesday.

- 7. Update on Health Departments would be revisited. Money may need to be added. \$1.5 million was available. Current bid \$1.9 million. Asphalt for parking lots was not included. Adjustments could be made to adjust the cost.
