

JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS
MISSISSIPPI COUNTY QUORUM COURT
June 25, 2024

The Quorum Court of Mississippi County, Arkansas, met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. in the Mississippi County Courthouse in Osceola, Arkansas with Judge John Alan Nelson presiding. Justice Cecil McDonald gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Justice White moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes as copies had been provided to the members. Justice Mangat seconded the motion and the voice vote was unanimous.

In the treasurer's report, Cindy George reported the interest rate at Farmers Bank in Blytheville on a \$100,000.00 CD was 5.25% for one year. She reported the sales tax revenue were down a bit from the previous month.

Committee Reports:

Planning and Development Committee: Justice White reported the committee met on June 17, 2024 with Clif Chitwood where GREDA presented several proposals to the committee.

- Request for Precision Field Services in the amount of \$400,000.00. 40 jobs, of which 15 will be new jobs. They are interested in the work here/live here program.
- Request for Lexicon in the amount of \$500,000.00 and they are interested in the work here/live here program.
- Request from Adams Gin/Land Co. in the amount of \$125,000.00 for 50 jobs of which 12 ½ will be full time.
- Invitation from John Newcomb from the Arkansas Economic Development Commission for the commission to meet in Mississippi County.

Finance Committee: Justice White reported the committee met on June 17, 2023. Topics of discussion were:

- Year to date expenditures were well within budgets.
- Motion was made and carried to appropriate \$21,500.00 for the Shug Banks Memorial Fund.
- Judge Dan Ritchey requested \$16,448.00 for the Drug Court Opioid Fund. Funds were appropriated.
- Finance Committee recommended appropriations for Precision Field Services (400,000.00), Lexicon (\$500,000.00), and Adams Gin/ Land Co. (\$125,000.00)
- JESAP would be submitted.
- Bid for the Annex improvements has been awarded to Sierra Group.
- Juvenile had a request for flooring in the amount of \$21,000.00.
- \$250,000.00 was appropriated from the ARPA funds for other repair projects.

- County Clerk Janice Currie has been awarded a \$50,000 grant to use for security purposes in the Osceola Courthouse and the Election Center in Blytheville. She is requesting \$14,000 to complete the project.

New Business:

The clerk was asked to read an ordinance titled: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING COMMITMENT TO PRECISION FIELD SERVICES. Following the reading, Justice White moved for adoption, Justice Mangat seconded and the vote was: Aye--- Ash, Burge, Cullom, Hepler, Jackson, Martin, Mangat, McDonald and White, Nay--- None, Absent---Brown and McClanahan. O-2024-23 was adopted by the court.

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING COMMITMENT TO LEXICON/PROSPECT STEEL. Following the reading and some discussion, Justice White moved for adoption, Justice Hepler seconded and the vote was: Aye---Hepler, Mangat, Martin, McDonald, and White; Nay---Ash, Burge, Cullom, and Jackson; Absent---Brown and McClanahan. O-2024-24 failed on the floor.

Following the vote to amend, Justice White moved for adoption, Justice Burge seconded and the vote was: Aye--- Ash, Burge, Cullom, Hepler, Jackson, Martin, McDonald and White, Nay--- None, Absent---Brown and McClanahan. O-2024-25 was adopted by the court

JUNE 24, 2024 1:30 ANNEX BUILDING**

1. Meeting was called to order by Justice Neil Burge. Meeting was turned over to Judge John Alan Nelson. Judge Nelson said the reason for this meeting was to discuss the Birdsong and Armored Fire Departments. They were going to disband. This was because there was a lack of volunteers and funding.

2. Tom Henry handed out maps, county districts, regulations, Resolutions, Act 833 funds distributed and certification requirements. Discussion was held.

3. Judge Nelson recommended for Joiner to cover Birdsong and Blytheville to cover Armored. The Joiner fire department was covering Birdsong. Blytheville Fire Chief Mike Carney said they would entertain the idea but needed to check into boundaries, manpower, equipment and expenses. The Committee suggested Judge Nelson meet with the Blytheville Mayor to discuss the possibilities.

4. Aaron Ruby informed Judge Nelson there was major electrical problems in the Osceola Courthouse. Most of the money allocated for Osceola would be needed to make the repairs. Justice Jackson would call an Energy & Property Meeting.

5. Judge Nelson needed to have a Sanitation and Solid Waste Meeting to discuss equipment. An excavator was destroyed by fire. The insurance company paid \$80,000.00 on the claim. More money was needed to purchase a new one.

6. Mississippi County would be hosing the Arkansas Aerospace and Defense Alliance on Wednesday.

3. Blytheville Courthouse update. Letter from Porter Brownlee was discussed. CNI had been released prior to the letter. Storm windows were complete. A statement was never received for the storm Windows. \$68,000.00. Money left \$380,543.77. The Blytheville Courthouse would be closing at 2:00 p.m. until the HAVAC was repaired in the original building. The Circuit Clerk's Office would remain open. D & L had not given a time when repairs would start. Compression fittings had to be replaced. Money left would be used for repairs.

4. Osceola Courthouse needed major electrical repairs. In Aaron Ruby's opinion it would take the entire money promised for repairs. \$1.5 million. The Historical Preservation would not permit new air units that were not currently in place. Hot water solution would be smaller units in the bathrooms. Cornice project was finishing up. Justice Burge recommended the money from the sale of the county property on Hwy, 61 go to the Osceola Courthouse. Motion was made by Justice Michael White to appropriate \$1.5 to update the electrical in the Osceola Courthouse plus the plaster in the Courtroom from County General. Second was made by Justice Betty Hepler. Motion passed and the request would go to Finance.
